Funding for High School athletics is rapidly disappearing. The totally volunteer, non-profit Hornet Boosters provides financial assistance that helps keep our Hornet athletic programs going, by supporting teams with such necessities as equipment, uniforms, transportation, and facilities improvements.

Most recently, the Boosters have funded our onsite Athletic Trainer who is available to provide injury prevention, treatment and rehabilitation to all Hornet athletes.

What You Can Do:

- **Family/Player Donations:** We hope that every Hornet family will make a \$60.00 per athlete/per sport donation.
- **Membership:** When your child participates in a sport, you automatically become a member of the Hornet Boosters. You are welcome to provide input and participate in all Booster meetings, events and activities.
- **Membership Upgrades:** Membership-Plus donations are also available (\$100, \$250, \$500 and \$1000) with significant added benefits.
- **Become a Parent Representative:** Each sport needs a team parent to represent it at the monthly Booster meetings. You can help by volunteering.
- **Attend Booster Events:** Each year the Boosters hold fundraising events so sport teams can receive equipment, etc., as needed. Teams are asked to participate and attend these events.

More about the Hornet Boosters:

The Hornet Boosters' primary purpose is to support AHS athletic programs. The organization raises money in 4 ways: Football Snack Bar sales, the Hornet Sting & other events, Family/Player donations and Booster Membership-Plus donations.

Goals:

1. Maintain/expand on-site Trainer Program and medical support for all sports.
2. Support team funding and transportation requests.
3. Develop an on-site tutor/athlete education program.
4. Support athletic facility infrastructure, as needed.

ALL monies collected by the Boosters through donations and Snack Bar sales go into a general fund to support ALL AHS sports. When a team has a need, the coach submits a request to the Boosters. The request is reviewed and, if approved, the need is fully or partially funded.

Booster meetings are held on the last Wednesday of the month at 6 pm in the Media Center Pit (unless otherwise noted on our website).
